



Flower Care Instructions

Annuals

- Fuschia – Part Sun/Shade. Fertilize & water regularly. Ensure proper drainage.
- Zonal Geranium – Sun/Part Sun. Water until soil is moist. Ensure proper drainage.
- Ivy Geranium - Sun/Part Sun. Water until soil is moist. Ensure proper drainage.
- Verbena – Full Sun. Water only when soil is dry. Fertilize monthly. Deadhead after first bloom.
- Gerbera Daisy – Full sun/Part shade. Water for evenly moist soil. Fertilize regularly.
- Callies Calibrachoa – Full/Part sun. Water regularly; maintain semi-moist soil.

Perennials

- Violet Viola – Sun/Part sun. Ht 8-10". Prefers well drained sandy soil. Deer resistant.
- Beardtongue – Full Sun. Ht 24". Best in fertile, well drained soil. Allow to dry between waterings. Attracts Hummingbirds.
- Columbine - Full Sun to Part Shade. Ht 20-28". Loose, average, well-drained soil. Attracts butterflies and hummingbirds.
- Shasta Daisy – Sun/Part Sun. Ht 14-18". Well drained soil. Deadhead faded flowers. Deer resistant. Attracts butterflies.
- Creeping Flox – Full Sun. Ht 4-6". Use as ground cover and rock gardens.
- Strawberry – Full Sun. Ht. 4-6". Summer fruiting. Keep soil evenly moist.
